**Footnotes**

PLEASANT BID stalked the early leaders four wide, rallied in the stretch late with urging and kicked clear. WILDWOOD LANE was within striking distance early racing between foes, went five wide in the stretch and closed. CHUECO'S SONG set the early pace drawing quickly clear, held to deep stretch then was challenged and faltered in the late going. GRANDAN hesitated at the break to be outrun early racing well off the rail, was the widest in the stretch and then showed some effort late. RUN LITTLE RED was allowed to settle early, placed a brief bid in the stretch then went evenly late. HOLLYWOOD HARRY was outrun early, went four wide and placed a mild bid. SQUATTY BOB was void of early speed saving ground and sustained a mild effort. LOOKS STORMY forced the early pace while saving ground then gave way. SILVER DEVIL R F raced mid pack early between foes, went five wide in the stretch and lacked a rally. MY PEEPERS faded steadily racing off the rail and was not a threat. KID CRAWFORD went six wide then retreated steadily. There was a Stewards Inquiry and after reviewing the films there was no changes made.
