JUMP WEST forced the early pace, sustained a bid between foes down the backstretch to gain a short lead, drifted five wide near the three sixteenths then drew clear in the stretch. CERTAINLY CERTAIN was within striking distance early along the inside, angled out between rivals to vie in the second turn, drifted out wide at the three sixteenths and didn't have enough late. CONSISTENTLYAFLEET moved up into the first turn six wide, angled in three wide to save some ground, then placed a brief bid near the quarter pole and flattened in the lane. KALYRA CAT was unhurried early, went four wide and sustained a mild effort. AUGHT EIGHT was outrun early racing off the rail and passed tiring foes. CALL IT A NIGHT was off slow early saving ground and lacked a late response. A GHOST BY CHOICE showed some brief speed, was used up early and gave way. CATRON COUNTY dropped back early, continued to fall back, was distanced and walked off.
