CHILE FIX set the early pace angling in to save ground, dueled briefly then inched away and was clear at the wire. CALL ME LUKE was within striking distance early along the rail, angled out near the five sixteenths and showed some interest late three wide. BAY HEAD SURPRISE stalked the early leaders four wide, sustained a bid nearing the three sixteenths then flattened in deep stretch but held the show. SANTIAGO'S LOVE prompted the early pace from the outside, placed a bid to duel briefly then weakened. JAZZ TIME was off slow early, circled the field into the stretch was the widest late and placed a mild bid. KID CRAWFORD was unhurried early saving ground and lacked a rally. FERNANDO'S EGO was outrun early, went five wide with a mild bid mid way then faded. EL CHAPARRAL was allowed to settle four wide then gave way. MR. B. G. went five wide and showed little. EL GATO DURAN saved ground to no avail.
