RUTHERFORD forced the early pace, placed a bid to draw clear, opened up in the stretch and increased his advantage. JAWBREAKER JACK was well back early saving ground, began to rally in the stretch and showed some interest late. NATHAN'S SPECIAL was unhurried early racing four wide, swung out seven wide in the stretch and showed some effort late. BUBBA WHO was forwardly placed early, sustained a brief bid then weakened. GONE SMOKIN was off slow early, went between foes and placed a mild bid. LEE'S GOLD raced mid pack saving ground and lacked a late response. WESTERN SHERIFF made a move mid way then faded. FOOLIN WHO showed brief speed, then stopped and was eased to the wire.
