Footnotes

ROAD TIME was within striking distance early, sustained a bid five wide, then angled in to save some ground, dueled in deep stretch, dug in the final yards and was best late. BEV'S FAST LANE bobbed at the break, recovered quickly to draw clear, was challenged into the stretch, dueled to nearing the wire but was outfinished. SOUR GIRL was unhurried early saving ground, showed some effort late and was along for the show. REMEMBER WHEN ROSE was void of early speed, circled the field six wide and placed a mild gain. W F DIAMOND HALO was outrun early, went four wide with a mild effort. LATENITE FINALE raced mid pack saving ground, made a move mid way angling three wide then faded. BASIN ST. HEIRESS chased the early leader four wide and was finished early. GOLDEN ROCKET was forwardly placed between rivals the retreated steadily.
