I'M WHO pressed the early pace, gained the lead then drew clear and increased her advantage. KALLIE'S STORM was within striking distance early along the inside, placed a bid into the stretch and got up for the place. PROSPECTIVE ERICA forced the early pace four wide, vied into the stretch then yielded and was outfinished for the place. EPIGRAPH was allowed to settle early between foes, went five wide late finishing evenly. OPENCONTAINER was unhurried early saving ground and lacked a gain late. PREMEDITATEDREDRUM dueled between rivals then gave way. BREA raced mid pack four wide and lacked a late response. LADYAMOR raced off the rail early, angled four wide and lacked a rally. ONE FOXY PRIVATE saved ground to no avail. HOLY HALLORY dropped back, raced wide and was not a factor. IN SONG showed little and was not a threat.
