SO LONG SASACYA was allowed to settle early, closed the gap three wide, gained a short lead near the quarter pole, battled into the stretch with strong urging and prevailed. TEXAS HOTTIE was unhurried early racing along the inside, gained ground into the stretch, was in tight quarters nearing the wire but held and was up for the place. EASY LOVING WHO forced the early pace from between foes, fought in deep stretch but didn't have enough late. WESTERN SILVER set a pressured early pace four wide, dueled into the stretch, lost path nearing the sixteenth pole, then altered out and went evenly. PREGAME was outrun early racing four wide and sustained a mild effort. QUALITY CHECK was off slow and placed a mild bid. TIN CAN FOOL raced wide in the stretch and passed tiring foes. JUSTA MILLION raced mid pack then faded. SAINT CLAIRE WHO pressed the early pace racing off the inside and was finished early. MUSICAL SWEETNESS was never a factor and outrun. The rider of WESTERN SILVER claimed interference against the rider of SO LONG SASACYA and after reviewing the films the Stewards determined there would be no change.
