TOPPER'S SONG was off slow early, saved ground while gaining ground, angled out between foes near the three sixteenth, dueled into the stretch and was best late. APT BAND was unhurried early, moved up three wide, was on even terms with the leader, dueled in deep stretch but was outfinished. FEISTY MISS prompted the early pace while saving ground, placed a bid to gain the lead at the quarter pole then came up empty in the stretch. FAST ISTINTAJ was outrun early, vied into the turn splitting foes then went evenly late. WILD TIME TONIGHT broke slow and placed a steady effort. DELTA MAGIC dropped back, went five wide and passed tiring foes. FOUND A PENNY showed early speed drawing clear then gave way. SLEWFULS STAR forced the early pace from between foes then faded. RED'S LASS placed a brief bid racing wide then tired. BEANER BEANER raced wide then retreated steadily.
