JESSTICKUM was within striking distance early, rallied four wide into the stretch, gained the advantage at the eighth pole, drifted in through the stretch and edged clear. VON HALO was allowed to settle early, went five wide into the stretch, closed well and found her best stride late. BOLIVAR SHAG prompted the early pace three wide, placed a bid to gain a short lead at the three sixteenths then flattened late. W F WILDCAT was unhurried early, vied nearing the eighth pole six wide and lacked a gain late. STARINGINHOLLYWOOD was off slow early and placed a mild effort late. FRANCISCO DE SALES drew quickly clear while saving ground then weakened at the quarter pole. TRACK TALK moved up racing just off the inside then gave way. COZY SARACEN trailed the field, raced wide and was eased to the wire.
