GRAND TEJAS moved up to set the early pace, edged clear, was challenged briefly near the quarter pole, responded to pressured and drew clear increasing his advantage in the stretch. TOO LOW FOR ZERO prompted the early pace from the outside, vied nearing the quarter pole then flattened and lacked a gain late. SIGHTLINES was off slow early racing off the inside, angled six wide in the stretch and gained the show. VICTOR WACO chased the early leader while saving ground then weakened. SMOLDER was off slow early to be outrun and passed tiring foes in the stretch. M C PETE raced mid pack four wide, drifted out in the stretch six wide and lacked a gain. COMSTOCK retreated steadily.
