**Footnotes**

DANSEUR WITH STARS set the early pace while saving ground, inched away into the turn, then edged clear in the stretch and proved best. CACTUS dueled briefly from the between foes three wide, failed to match strides with the winner but held the place. AZTHEHOTWALKTURNS was unhurried early, swung out six wide and closed well to gain the show. CITY CARTEL prompted the early pace four wide, placed a bid in the turn then flattened. HOLLYWOOD HARRY was allowed to settle early saving ground and lacked a late effort. MR ERIC was off slow early saving ground and lacked a rally. RUN LITTLE RED was outrun early, went four wide and was not a factor. BOOK MATCHES showed brief speed then faded. DOUBLE RECESS trailed the field and was always outrun.
