Footnotes

RUNNING SQUALL broke outward at the break then settled to stalk the leader three wide, placed a bid between rivals at the quarter pole and edged clear with moderate urging. OUR FORTRESS set the early pace drawing clear along the inside, was challenged nearing the quarter pole and failed to match strides in the stretch. NUMBERONESON tracked the early leaders along the inside, rallied at the top of the stretch then went evenly late. JANNAS PRIDE was forwardly placed early racing three wide and lacked a gain in the stretch four wide. IM TOO A TRUBADOR broke slowly then moved up along the inside, angled three wide at the eighth pole and came up empty. LEADSHANK was close briefly racing down the backstretch then gave way. FIRE BRIGADE trailed the field and was always outrun.
