SPARTAN WARRIOR chased the early leader along the inside, angled out four wide into the turn, placed a bid and surged clear in deep stretch. TEHUANTEPECER was unhurried early while saving ground, angled out four wide to rally in the stretch and closed to gain the place. SOUTHPAW WHO dueled from along the inside with FRED'S HENNESSY, was challenged nearing the quarter pole then weakened in the stretch. MYSTICALUNDERTONES broke slow, placed a steady effort to the top of the stretch then went evenly. FRED'S HENNESSY dueled from the outside and was finished early. JENNA'S MIRACLE was outrun early, went six wide and lacked a late response. PAPPAS GOLD was within striking distance racing four wide, drifted out wide late and gave way. MI DOMSCAT saved ground and was eased to the wire.
