LESTERS GIRL was unhurried early, circled the field into the stretch, wore down her foes in the stretch and surged clear late. DEVIL'S PROSPECTOR set the early pace, drew quickly clear, held advantage into the stretch, bobbled nearing the eighth pole then yielded in the drive but held the place. DOME SHADOWS stalked the early leaders from the inside, sustained a brief bid nearing the quarter pole then weakened. WHIRLIN N TWIRLIN chased the early leaders, then tired and faded. BENEZIR failed to threaten. TELLITOTHEJUDGE was hard to load in the gate, then broke slowly and was not a factor. COMICAL KARON retreated steadily.
