KISS MY HENNESSY set the early pace saving ground, was challenged in the stretch, responded to pressure and surged clear. SLEW UP HIS SLEEVE was forwardly placed early, sustained a bid three wide, was on even terms with the leader at the eighth pole but didn't have enough late. CANTANKEROUS was unhurried early, rallied four wide with a mild bid and was along for the show. YOU FOLLOW ME forced the early pace three wide then weakened. SUPER SALTY was within striking distance early, went five wide into the stretch, drifted out and lacked a bid. LE GRANDE LOOKER was close in the early going saving ground then gave way. INDY'S ROCKET was off slow and failed to threaten. FORT PHANTOM showed little in a dull effort. ROLL WESTWARD failed to menace.
