FUNNY JUSTICE was off slow early, sustained a bid between foes into the stretch, closed well three wide and prevailed at the wire. VITAL FORCE was wide into the first turn, then advanced down the backstretch four wide, gained the lead nearing the quarter pole, had a clear advantage in the stretch then flattened out in the late going. ROYAL DEVIL was unhurried early, placed and effort late four wide and was along for the show. TEJANO TROUBLE was allowed to settle early, shuffled back down the backstretch, then came back six wide late. AUSTIN LIGHTS was void of early speed and placed a mild bid late. CANTALLBECHIEFS set the early pace, drew quickly clear, was finished after a half and faded. THE BIG ONE was within striking distance early then retreated steadily. ABSOLUT BURN was outrun and raced wide throughout. VINNY V. chased the early leader racing off the rail then gave way. THUNDER BELLE retreated steadily.
