VERA'S KEY pressed the early pace three wide, placed a bid to duel into the stretch, lost ground mid stretch then battled back nearing the wire and was just up. DUMPSEY JEAN was off slow early racing off the inside, rallied in the stretch to alter inward near the sixteenth and closed well but missed. FOUND A PENNY moved up along the inside, dueled into the stretch, edged clear three wide then gave way grudgingly in deep stretch. BELLE OF ABO prompted the early pace four wide, placed a brief bid into the turn then flattened. MAY LASS dueled from between rivals, angled in stretch and weakened. MORE FUN was outrun early, went five wide and lacked a bid. MARIES FAST LADY showed little in a dull effort.
