R BLING was unhurried early, vied into the turn, splitting foes then angled in along the rail and closed well to get up in the final strides. A PENNY LANE set the early pace three wide, drew clear into the stretch, began to weakened nearing the wire and was outfinished. GO TO GOLD stalked the early leaders three wide, sustained a bid in the stretch and was gaining late. LEMON FEVER was allowed to settle early four wide, placed a brief bid then drifted out in the stretch and flattened. METER ME GONE was forwardly placed saving ground, drifted out six wide in the stretch and lacked a rally. CHARMING MOVES was off slow early, went seven wide into the stretch and improved her position. R LA PATRONA forced the early pace saving ground and was finished early. SUNNY STEIN broke in a tangle and unseated her rider.
