DISAPPEARING FLY forced the early pace from the inside, placed a bid to duel with LUCKY JOHN, kicked clear in the stretch and widened. LUCKY JOHN broke sharply to set the early pace, dueled into the stretch, was challenged near the eighth pole then yielded and was no match for the winner. THREEGOODKIDS was forwardly placed racing off the inside, lacked a gain late but held the show. CALL IT A NIGHT was unhurried early while saving ground, placed a brief bid drifting out in the stretch and faded. MAKENNA'S GOLD raced mid pack five wide, lacked a rally and showed little. RGIRLSGOTRHYTHM was outrun racing four wide then gave way. JUANTAWIN was off slow, trailed the field and was always outrun. FAST BUCK was taken up shortly after the break and vanned off.
