### Footnotes

DESERT GAMBLE forced the early pace from between rivals, vied into the second turn to draw clear at the eighth, dug in through the stretch and held sway. MOJAVE PRINCE was allowed to settle early while saving ground, angled out four wide into the second turn, placed a bid to close well but missed in the final yards. CATCH THE BEAN was forwardly placed early four wide, sustained a brief bid down the backstretch then yielded in the drive. DOUBLE SMART was within striking distance early along the inside, angled between rivals at the three sixteenth and lacked a gain late. OUR CHOICE was unhurried early racing off the rail, went four wide in the stretch and placed a mild effort. KY'S QUEST was outrun, showed little and improved his position in the stretch. BRAX was hustled away to show some early speed and was finished after a half.
