Footnotes

WHO LEFT WHO set the early pace drawing quickly clear, was challenged in the turn, responded to pressured, edged clear in deep stretch and held. I DO MY OWN TRICKS stalked the early leaders three wide, placed a bid in deep stretch and gained the place. SUPERSONIC STAR broke slowly then moved up quickly along the rail to be in contention and flattened in the drive. GRANDE HADLEY was within striking distance early four wide and lacked a gain in the late going. JACKPOT MAGIC raced mid pack off the rail, drifted out wide in the stretch and was not a factor. TARAHUMAR FLAGS broke inward at the break bumping a rival, then was unhurried racing off the rail and was not a threat. MARRSCRYPT prompted the early pace saving ground then gave way. ALLMOUR dropped back early racing off the inside and showed little. DEUCE LUTUI was bumped at the break, raced well off the rail and failed to menace.
