SHAME ON CHARLIE chased the early leaders three wide, sustained a bid near the five sixteenths, moved up on even terms with OH YA, dug in the final strides and was all out at the wire to prove best. OH YA pressed the early pace from the outside, dueled with TRICK RYDER down the backstretch, edged clear into the turn, was headed in deep stretch and outfinished. IN THE MOMENT was unhurried early saving ground, angled out four wide to place a bid at the eighth pole and sustained a mild bid. DELATORE was outrun early saving ground and placed a steady effort. GONE SMOKIN was off slow early while saving ground, angled out between rivals in the stretch and placed a mild gain. TRICK RYDER set the early pace, dueled down the backstretch, was finished early and gave way. SAINT OFTHEVALLEY raced mid pack five wide and lacked a rally. BARNEYS SONG dropped back racing well off the rail and passed tiring foes. RUFF GAL made a mild move mid way then faded. AWESOME AUSSIE tracked the early leader saving ground then retreated. There was a Stewards Inquiry into the break and after reviewing the films it was determined there would be no change.
