EL CUERVITO drew quickly clear down the backstretch, was challenged briefly near the quarter pole, responded to pressure and held well late. THUMPER'S DEVIL was off slow early, rallied four wide in the stretch and found his best stride late. NOTIME TO BADINAGE raced mid pack, angled in down the backstretch to save some ground and gained the show late. RUN LUV RUNN chased the early leader from the outside, sustained a brief bid near the quarter pole then weakened. YUKON'S GOLD was void of early speed, went five wide and placed a mild effort late. DESERT SPRINGS showed little in a dull effort. UBER ALEX faded steadily and was the widest in the stretch. SHARON'S SHADOW stalked the early leaders for a quarter, then dropped back and was not a factor.
