DOMS THUNDER was unhurried early along the rail, angled out three wide between rivals into the stretch, battled through the lane then surged clear. CHASING OUR DREAMS chased the early leader four wide, rallied in the stretch, didn't have enough late and was outfinished. FAST A NUFF tracked the early leader along the rail, angled out three wide to place a bid, gained the lead then finished on the inside and yielded. RUNNING SQUALL was well back early racing four wide, swung out mid track at the top of the stretch and showed some effort late. DODSON was outrun early, went five wide at the three sixteenths placing a mild bid then faded. BAD BAD LEROY WHO failed to threaten. MY PICASSO showed early speed along the rail then stopped.
