GIANT PROSPECTOR set the early pace three wide, edged clear into the stretch, drew off and opened up. PERTY IMPRESSIVE was unhurried early saving ground, showed some effort late to gain the place but was not a threat to the winner. PAYDIRT PETE forced the early pace along the rail and came up empty in the drive. SIX MILLION was allowed to settle early, went three wide and placed a mild bid. GENERAL O was outrun early, went five wide and lacked a late response. BAY STAR RISING was void of early speed, saved ground and passed tiring foes in the lane. ROMAN FOX forwardly placed four wide and was finished early. SECRET SHINE showed little in a dull effort. DESERT DOME went five wide and faded steadily. ZAGORA TOO failed to threaten.
