JERDAN HILL chased the early leaders two or three wide, sustained a bid into the stretch, took command and drew off. HOLY HALLORY dropped back early to be well outrun, then placed a steady effort into the second turn, went seven wide in the stretch and closed. FLOOD ZONE was unhurried early while saving ground, angled out four wide and was along for the show. WHOLE LOTTA BULL set the early pace racing off the rail and was finished after a half. KNOXVILLE GIN was allowed to settle early, went five wide placing a brief bid then flattened. SNOWBALL SMARTY was forwardly placed early then retreated steadily and was eased to the wire. MOLLY MIDNIGHT raced mid pack four wide, was taken up in the second turn near the quarter pole and walked off. QUEENLY DELIGHT outrun early, was taken up near the eighth pole and walked off.
