MISTER LANE set the early pace racing off the rail, drew clear into the turn, was challenged in deep stretch then dug in and held sway. PAGADOR was unhurried early along the rail, began to close the gap into the turn, rallied angling out three wide and was gaining. ZORRA SUAVE was allowed to settle early three wide, sustained a bid between foes at the three sixteenth, drifted out some int he stretch and went evenly. CHIEF FIRE WATER was forwardly placed early four wide, shuffled back in the turn, angled out six wide near the three sixteenth and placed a late bid. MY PRECIOUS LADY was unhurried early, went three wide and placed a mild bid. ONE QUICK BUDDY pressed the early pace three wide, weakened drifting out five wide in the stretch. DELL CITY BLUES was off slow early, dropped back then improved his position in the stretch. CRICKET BOY angled in along the rail and was not a factor.
