Footnotes

DANCING GHOST set the early pace drawing clear along the inside, held on and just lasted. GATOR GULCH was unhurried early, rallied in the stretch, was gaining fast but was out nodded. B R BIG RED angled in leaving the chute to force the early pace then weakened in the stretch but held the show. ATTILA'S GHOST was outrun early, went three wide and showed some interest late. ELWAY was steadied leaving the chute when BR BIG RED drifted inward, then angled out five wide and lacked a rally. QUINTON'S FIRE saved ground to no avail. TOM'S HAT was bumped hard and forced to steady leaving the chute then dropped back. STORM DANCING was knocked off stride leaving the chute then dropped out and was not a factor. The rider of ELWAY claimed interference against the rider of BR BIG RED and after reviewing the films it was determined that BR BIG RED would be disqualified and placed last for interference leaving the chute.
