HANK ACE chased the early leader racing off the rail, closed the gap down the backstretch, took command into the second turn and widened. WESTERN ACT was within striking distance early, vied four wide at the three sixteenth, finished willingly but was no match for the winner. SIR STEPHEN was off slow early racing off the rail, angled five wide to place a bid, then flattened in the stretch but held the show. PERSHING was pinched back at the start to be outrun early, raced off the inside, placed a brief bid at the eighth pole between rivals then weakened. ONE TOUGH HOMBRE broke inward at the break, saved ground and failed to threaten. BANKER'S D LIGHT made a move mid way then faded. OTISISGOLD was void early speed and showed little. BOURBON CAT showed some brief speed, was used up early and stopped.
