EXTRA HALO showed early speed into the first turn saving ground, settled down the backstretch to chase OURHORSEWITHNONAME then placed a bid into the second turn, gained the advantage, was challenged in deep stretch, battled gamely then inched away. MR. PLAY MISTY prompted the early pace from the outside, rallied four wide to challenge the leader but didn't have enough late. CRUSADEN was unhurried early saving ground, angled five wide and showed some interest to gain the show. DOUBLE RECESS was outrun early racing off the rail, vied in the stretch and showed some effort late. RUN LITTLE RED was off slow early, went three wide and placed a mild bid. LINCOLN COUNTY WAR raced mid pack five wide, sustained a brief bid then weakened. OURHORSEWITHNONAME pressed the early pace from the inside, gained a lead down the backstretch then tired and was finished early. TEHUANTEPECER saved ground to no avail. BANDONTHELOOSE dropped back early, lost contact with the field and was distanced.
