CONDENSED was off slow early, placed a steady effort into the stretch, went five wide and closed fast late to prove best. DR. DIZZLE forced the early pace from between rivals, gained a short lead at the eighth pole and failed to hold of a fast closing rival. UBER ALEX set the early pace racing four wide, weakened in the stretch but held the show. WAR WIN was void of early speed, vied in the turn, went five wide in the stretch and showed some effort late. BAND OF RED raced mid pack in the early going while saving ground and lacked a rally. HOLLYWOOD DUDE pressed the early pace racing off the inside, gained a lead briefly into the turn then gave way. TUPAY was within striking distance early between foes then faded. AMAZING PACHE failed to menace. BALLADO'S BULLET was outrun and never a factor.
