**Footnotes**

HIGHEST HUMOR was unhurried early, began to close the gap along the rail, slipped thru at the top of the stretch and kicked clear. DANDY DANCER stalked the early leaders, went six wide at the three sixteenths, was urged steadily and gained the place. ROBYN LANE set a pressured early pace racing off the inside, edged clear into the stretch then faltered when challenged. BALLISTIC HEAT was outrun early, went three wide and showed some interest late. BLUE MEMO forced the early pace three wide and was finished early. JANZIG AFFAIR was off slow, moved up along the rail to be within striking, then angled out three wide and weakened. DELATORE dropped back to trail the field and was always outrun.
