Footnotes

FLIPSON raced mid pack along the inside, vied into the second turn, slipped thru at the top of the stretch to gain a short lead at the eighth pole then drew clear. JICK JACK JOKER was void of early speed, gained steadily down the backstretch, went seven wide at the top of the stretch and closed well. POWERFUL PETE was unhurried early, placed a steady effort racing off the inside and was up for the show. PAY THE VIG was outrun early, went six wide and lacked a late effort. MAGNIFICENT STORM lagged behind into the first turn, then showed some interest late between rivals in the stretch. CANSAN CAKEWALK showed no early speed and placed a mild bid late. STRIKINOUT N MIAMI was within striking distance early racing well off the inside, sustained a brief bid near the three sixteenths then gave way. CHEROKEE STALKER set a pressured early pace from the outside, was used up early then tired and retreated. BIG DIVOT pressed the early pace from the inside and was finished after a half. SKIPRIANNA dropped steadily back and was eased to the wire.
