GULCHRNSSWEET showed early speed drawing quickly clear, was never challenged and much the best. BONNDADDY'S chased the early leader from the inside, drifted out some in the stretch and was no match for the winner. CATABOLIZE stalked the early leader three wide, placed a brief bid at the quarter pole failed to seriously threat the winner but fought for the show late. KINGS LEGACY raced mid pack and lacked a closing response. ROSA'S CATENA was outrun while saving ground and showed little. BLUSHING FINA was forwardly placed racing off the inside then gave way. H. E.'S FAST was off slow early and failed to threaten racing five wide. MT. FRANKLIN dropped back early, raced wide and failed to menace. EXCESS FOLLY retreated steadily.
