**Footnotes**

CHILE FIX forced the early pace from along the rail, sustained a bid to gain the advantage in the turn then drew off in the stretch. FIRE E BEAN was never far back in the early going, went six wide to rally, placed a steady effort into the stretch then went evenly. BAD BAD LEROY WHO was unhurried early, vied five wide and was along for the show. CACTUS showed early speed dueling briefly then weakened. MURDEROUS was allowed to settle early, went six wide and placed a mild bid. KING OF THE DANCE was void of early speed and passed tiring foes. HOLLYWOOD HARRY was outrun early, sustained a brief bid four wide then flattened. SENOR PROSPECT was forwardly placed early five wide then gave way. PENALTY BOX dueled briefly from between rivals and was finished early.
