Footnotes

KALYRA CAT tracked the early leaders along the inside, angled out four wide between the eighth pole and the sixteenth pole, then closed with a rush when clear. SOUTHPAW WHO prompted the early pace three wide, went between foes to gain a short lead at the eighth pole but was outfinished by closing rival. CERTAINLY CERTAIN stalked the early leaders three wide and lacked a gain late. THE HUNT IS ON was forwardly placed early, went four wide and lacked a late response. MENDOTA SLEW showed early speed saving ground, edged clear into the first turn, was challenged into the second turn then gave way. MR MCLINTOCK broke slow at the start, went three wide and was outrun. BORN TO WALTZ was unhurried early saving ground then faded steadily. AUGHT EIGHT dropped back, raced wide and trailed throughout.
