Footnotes

CALL IT A NIGHT was allowed to settle early, closed the gap to the top of the stretch, angled four wide nearing the eighth pole finished well and was up in the final strides. BOLD ENTITY pressed the early pace four wide, dueled into the stretch with RGIRLSGOTRHYTHM, gained a short advantage on that foe but was outfinished in the final going. HELIOBULL was outrun early along the inside, angled three wide into the stretch, altered inward nearing the sixteenth pole and placed a late rally. B. A. CON was off slow early, went five wide and showed some interest late. RGIRLSGOTRHYTHM set a pressured early pace, dueled into the stretch and came up empty. GROUCHY WHO was within striking distance early five wide and was finished early. BOLIVAR SHAG moved up along the rail to place a brief bid then gave way. CANOSO ESPIA trailed the field and passed a tiring foe late. WEST OF TEXAS forced the early pace three wide between foes then retreated steadily.
