Footnotes

HAPPY HUMOR set the early pace racing off the inside, edged clear quickly, then opened up in the stretch and proved best. SUNNY TOPPER was off slow early, raced wide, closed well late and got up for the place. HANGINGATARNIE'S forced the early pace three wide then came up empty in the drive. METALLIC MIST was unhurried early, showed some effort late with a mild gain. AZTEC KING tracked the early leaders from along the rail then weakened. ACTUALLY was forwardly placed early five wide then gave way. ANCIENT APPEAL raced mid pack then faded steadily after a quarter. ONE BELL OF A BULL failed to threaten. KINETICAT YANKEE was off slow early, dropped back steadily, fell near the seven sixteenth and was vanned off. There was a Stewards Inquiry and after reviewing the films it was determined there would be no change.
