STORM OF STORMS pressed the early pace four wide, sustained a bid to gain a short lead, then dueled into the stretch and inched away to prevail. PLATINUM PRO was off slow early, gained steadily, went three wide between foes into the stretch, closed well but didn't have enough late. JIM WADE set a pressured early pace, lost the advantage down the backstretch then fought back to duel into the stretch but was outrunished. GO BLAKERS GO raced mid pack, sustained a brief bid nearing the three sixteenths then flattened in the drive. SILVER DEVIL R F gate opened pre start, then broke well to force the early pace racing off the inside and tired. NITETRAINTONOWHERE was off slow early, closed the gap racing five wide then went evenly late. B R SANDSTORM was unhurried early and lacked a late response. BATTLE CREEK HIWAY gate opened pre start, then was off slow, made a move mid way then faded. PAPA STAN was forwardly placed early along the inside then retreated steadily and was eased to the wire. REFRESHING STORM raced mid pack saving ground then lost his rider near the seven sixteenth. There was a Stewards Inquiry and after reviewing the films it was determined there would be no change.
