WAFER bid three wide into the turn, edged clear into the lane and held well under mild urging. WESTERN QUALITY made a four wide into the turn and hung late to finish second best. SOUTHERN POWER vied for the lead inside and faded through the lane. RADICAL LAUREN put in an even effort and failed to menace. SOARING EGO vied for the lead two wide and faltered into the turn. SMASH TICKET rushed up inside early and fell back. NASTY IN PUMPS showed little as did FULLACHARM. BOSTASHA had brief speed only. KEY TO FANTASY was never a factor nor was OH BEHAVE. SAUCINESS was always outrun.
