Footnotes

REGATTA TONE was within striking distance early, went six wide circling the field into the second turn, surged clear and was best late. PERSHING set the early pace saving ground, drew clear briefly into the stretch but was outfinished by a closing rivals. SEA BATTLE was unhurried early, rallied into the stretch eight wide and finished well to get up for the show. AWESOME LAUNCH was outrun early racing well off the inside between foes, went seven wide in the stretch and placed a mild bid. STORMIN STORY was off slow early saving ground and placed a mild effort late. CONTINUUM was void of early speed, went four wide and passed tiring foes in the stretch. ONE TOUGH HOMBRE was forwardly placed early five wide then gave way. RUFF LAD forced the early pace from between foes and was finished after a half. RUHLUM went four wide and retreated steadily.
