LOTA TALENT forced the early pace from between foes, vied to gain the advantage nearing the eighth pole and held off a closing foe late. OUR CHOICE was unhurried early, split rivals nearing the five sixteenth marker, rallied in the stretch four wide and closed well. LESTERS SECRET set the early pace while saving ground, was challenged into the stretch then weakened. LANE STORMER hopped at the start to get off slowly then sustained a steady effort five wide. BROTHER LOUIE chased the early leaders racing off the inside then tired. DESERT GAMBLE was void of early speed racing off the inside and placed a mild bid. TRAIN RIDER BLUES was slow early and passed tiring foes in the stretch. SILVER MATTHAIS saved ground to no avail. FULLOFENERGY prompted the early pace three wide, was finished early and faded.
