Footnotes

OUR FLYING ANGEL set the early pace from between foes, dueled with SANDIA SONATA into the stretch, gained a short lead at the eighth pole then edged clear. SANDIA SONATA prompted the early pace four wide, placed a bid to duel into the stretch but was outfinished in the final furlong. ROLL BLOOMERS ROLL was unhurried early, went six wide to show some effort late and gained the show. EASY LOVING WHO was forwardly placed early saving ground and lacked a gain late. LADY ANNABELLA was off slow early, went six wide in the stretch and showed some effort late. LAYNE'S BEST raced mid pack and lacked a closing response. WESTERN SILVER was outrun early, went four wide and showed little. QUINTON'S DOLL WHO was void of early speed and improved her position. SILENCE N SOLITUDE forced the early pace from between rivals and was finished early. NEW GOLD was close in the early going then gave way.
