**Footnotes**

TRAIN RIDER BLUES was unhurried early racing five wide down the backstretch, angled in near the five sixteenth to save some ground, sustained a bid shifting out three wide at the top of the stretch, split foes closing well and was up in the final strides. MY PICASSO was outrun early racing five wide, angled in through the turn and closed well along the inside through the stretch. LESTER'S ECHO pressed the early pace from along the inside, placed a bid to draw clear at the eighth pole then flattened in the final furlong. SMASH DANCER was close in the early going between rivals, was steadied nearing the seven sixteenth marker, then angled out four wide to place a bid then went evenly late. MAYBE TO FAST was forwardly placed early racing six wide, yielded in the turn then placed a mild effort in the stretch. HOLLYWOOD THUNDER broke sharply to set the early pace and was finished after a half. RIG'S RUNNER forced the early pace four wide and came up empty in the stretch. EIGHTNCHANGEGROOM raced mid pack four wide and weakened. CRAFTY YOU was outrun and failed to menace. GO BARNEY GO saved ground to no avail. HEZA RARE BULL was off slow early while saving ground, angled three wide at the eighth pole and lacked a bid. TINZAR was widest in the stretch and not a factor.
