SCOOBA DE forced the early pace, placed a bid three wide to duel into the stretch, edged clear and held well. OMER'S SURE SHOT was unhurried early, rallied four wide in the stretch, finished well but didn't have enough late. ACTIVATED prompted the early pace, moved up to duel into the stretch, came up empty in the late going but held the show. L'NATURAL BULL was unhurried early along the inside and sustained a mild late effort. LE GRANDE SUCCESS was well back in the early going, was steadied slightly into the turn then improved his position in the stretch. MR. WINDFALL dueled three wide, was finished early and gave way. HESAPOGILOOKER raced mid track in the stretch and faded. S S BULL IT raced wide and was not a factor.
