PREFERRED MANDATE set the early pace racing off the inside, dueled briefly then edged clear into the stretch and held sway. REMUS was unhurried early, went five wide to show some interest late and gained the place. RELENTLESS SLEW was outrun early, rallied four wide into the stretch and was along for the show. CROOKED AS CAN BE prompted the early pace three wide then tired and gave way. GAMES GOOD was allowed to settle early, then moved up along the rail to place a brief bid near the five sixteenths then gave way. DOWNTOWN CHARLIE was forwardly placed four wide then faded. ROCKIN HARBOR trailed the field and was always outrun.
