MAYBE TO FAST was allowed to settle early, went three wide to place a bid nearing the quarter pole, gained the advantage at the eighth pole, was challenged in deep stretch but held well. ADMIRAL'S CROWN was off slow early saving ground, angled out four wide near the three sixteenths to rally into the stretch and was gaining late. CHASING OUR DREAMS forced the early pace from the inside, placed a brief bid at the quarter pole then flattened in the drive. FRED'S HENNESSY set the early pace three wide, was challenged near the quarter pole then weakened. RIVER GRADE TRICK was outrun early racing off the rail and improved his position in the stretch. CHROME BOY went four wide and faded steadily.
