Footnotes

TING showed early speed, drew clear into the turn, opened up through the stretch and was ridden out. BURBANK TOO was hustled away along the inside, lost some ground in the turn then battled back in deep stretch to gain the place. RGIRLSGOTRHYTHM stalked the early leaders three wide, sustained a bid to be within striking then flattened in the drive. VALID HI TECK was unhurried early, rallied in the turn circling the field five wide and placed a mild effort. PARADE DRESS raced mid pack off the inside and lacked a late response. IT'S NEVER EASY dropped back, went four wide and improved her position in the stretch. ONGO broke slow, raced off the rail and was not a factor.
