POWERFUL PETE was well back racing between foes into the backstretch, began to close the gap into the second turn, split foes at the three sixteenths then kicked clear nearing the sixteenth pole. YIELD A WINNER set the early pace racing four wide, drew clear down the backstretch, was challenged in deep stretch and was no match late. PAY THE VIG was unhurried early, gained steadily racing four wide and was along for the show. DIXIE BANDJO was within striking distance saving ground and lacked a gain late. WHOS LAZY prompted the early pace along the inside then came up empty in the stretch. HOLLYWOOD THUNDER was forwardly placed early four wide and was finished after a half. HAPPY JACK raced mid pack, went six wide in the stretch and was no threat. OUR STORM trailed the field, raced wide throughout, was eased to the wire and walked off after pulling up.
