CABRIOLA moved up four wide to take command into the turn and held a safe advantage to the wire. NO MORE DAY'S stalked the early leaders four wide, vied in the stretch to gain the place but was outfinished for the win. LEO'S BEEN KATTIN was unhurried early, went five wide nearing the three sixteenths, showed some effort late and was along for the show. MICAELA was within striking distance early saving ground, angled out between rivals at the three sixteenths to place a bid then weakened in the drive and was vanned off after pulling up. MALARIA was outrun early, went five wide and placed a mild bid. DESERT ECHO was off slow early saving ground and improved her position in the stretch. STILLNESS raced mid pack four wide and lacked a late effort. DELA'S FORTUNE raced off the rail and faded steadily. SPECIALLY FAST stumbled at the start to get away slowly, then dropped back and was not a threat. JOSEPHINE BLAIR showed some brief speed inside then stopped.
